1. EXHIBITORS MUST BE ECEA MEMBERS TO QUALIFY FOR DAILY HIGH POINT AWARDS & YEAR END AWARDS.
2. EXHIBITORS MUST COMPETE IN AT LEAST 3 OF THE 5 SHOWS **ON THE SAME HORSE** TO QUALIFY FOR YEAR END AWARDS.
3. EXHIBITORS MUST SHOW IN HALTER AND AT LEAST ONE WESTERN AND ONE ENGLISH CLASS TO QUALIFY FOR DAILY HIGH POINT, AND MUST BE A MEMBER.
4. HALTER POINTS **DO** COUNT TOWARD DAILY HIGH POINT AWARDS.
5. ONE HORSE – ONE RIDER RULE APPLIES IN ALL CLASSES.
6. YOUTH 18 AND UNDER MAY NOT SHOW STALLIONS OF ANY AGE.
7. A **GREEN NOVICE RIDER** IS A GREEN HORSE OR NOVICE RIDER, OR ANYONE NOT COMFORTABLE SHOWING IN AGE CATEGORIES REQUIRING A 3RD GAIT. **THIS HORSE/RIDER COMBO MAY NOT CROSS OVER INTO ANY OTHER CATEGORY.** MUST BE 11 YEARS OLD OR OLDER AS A RIDER.
8. **LEADLINE/WALK & WHOA** EXHIBITORS MAY NOT CROSS OVER INTO ANY OTHER RIDING CLASS.
9. TRAIL IN HAND HORSES MAY NOT ENTER ANY RIDING CLASS.
10. PONY/MINI HALTER IS FOR MARES & GELDINGS 14.2 HANDS & UNDER.
11. RANCH PERFORMANCE, HUNTER HACK, AND JACKPOT CLASSES DO NOT FALL UNDER DIVISIONS AND MAY BE RIDDEN BY ANY HORSE/RIDER COMBINATION. THESE WILL NOT COUNT TOWARD DAILY HIGH POINT.
12. **10 & UNDER** DIVISION RIDERS WILL ONLY BE REQUIRED TO COMPETE WITH 2 GAITS.
13. **11-13, 14-18, AND ADULT** DIVISIONS WILL BE REQUIRED TO COMPETE WITH 3 GAITS.
14. ANY AGE DIVISION IS DETERMINED BY THE AGE THE RIDER IS ON JANUARY 1 OF THAT SHOW YEAR.

_____ 1) **Registration of visitors/riders and agreement purpose:** In consideration of the payment of a fee and signing of this agreement, I, the following listed individual and the parent or legal guardian thereto if a minor, do hereby agree to hire this Stable, horse(s), equipment & personnel for the purpose of animal & horse-related activities today and all future dates.

_____ 2) **Agreement Scope and Territory Definitions:** This agreement shall be legally binding upon me the registered visitors &/or riders and the parents or legal guardians thereof if a minor, my heirs, estate, assignees, including all minor children and personal representatives; and it shall be interpreted according to the laws of the state and county of this Stables physical location. Any dispute by the rider shall be litigated in and venue shall be the county in which this Stable is physically located. If any clause, phrase, or word is in conflict with state law, then that single part is null and void. The term “HORSE” herein shall refer to riding or otherwise handling of horses, ponies, mules or donkeys, whether from the ground or mounted. The term “RIDER” shall herein refer to a person who rides a horse mounted or otherwise handles or comes near a horse or ranch livestock from the ground.

_____ 3) **Conditions of Nature:** I UNDERSTAND THAT THIS RANCH/STABLE IS NOT responsible for total or partial or minute acts, occurrences or elements of nature that can scare a horse, pony or other livestock, cause it to fall or react in some unsafe way.

_____ 4) **Release of Photographs:** I hereby grant River Ranch Educational Charities the irrevocable right and permission, throughout the world, in connection with the photograph(s) that were taken of me or which I provided to River Ranch Educational Charities.

_____ 5) **Carry ± On Objects and Sharp Noises:** I UNDERSTAND THAT Riders &/or visitors interacting with ranch animals must not carry loose items which may fall, blow away, flap in the wind, bounce, or make sharp noises, possibly scaring a horse or additional livestock.

_____ 6) **Activity Risk Classification:** I UNDERSTAND THAT: Horseback riding is classified as RUGGED ADVENTURE RECREATIONAL SPORT ACTIVITY and that there are numerous obvious and non-obvious inherent risks always present in such activity despite all safety precautions. Related injuries can be severe requiring more hospital days and resulting in more lasting residual effects than injuries in other activities. I/WE further understand that applicant may be participating in a “WILDERNESS EXPERIENCE”. The meaning of this term is defined as follows: **THE PURSUIT OF ADVENTURE TYPE OF ACTIVITY IN A WILD, RUGGED, UNCULTIVATED AREA OR REGION, AS OF FOREST AND/OR HILLS AND/OR MOUNTAINS AND/OR PLAINS AND/OR WETLANDS, WHICH WOULD LIKELY BE UNINHABITED BY PEOPLE AND INHABITED BY WILD ANIMALS OF MANY TYPES AND SPECIES TO INCLUDE MAMMALS, REPTILES AND INSECTS, WHICH ARE NOT TAME, MAY BE SAVAGE AND UNPREDICTABLE IN NATURE AND WANDERING AT WILL.**

_____ 7) **Nature of Stable Horses:** I UNDERSTAND THIS STABLE chooses its rental horses for their calm dispositions and sound basic training as is required for the use as riding horses for novice and beginning riders and THIS STABLE follows a rigid safety program. Yet, no horse is a completely safe horse. Horses are 5 to 10 times larger, 20 to 40 times more powerful and 3 to 4 times faster than a human. If a rider falls from a horse to the ground, it will generally be at a distance of from 3.5 – 5.5 feet and the impact may result in injury to the rider. Horseback riding is the only sport where one much smaller, weaker predator animal (human) tries to impose its will on another much larger, stronger prey animal with a mind of its own (horse) and each has limited understanding of the other. If a horse is frightened or provoked it may divert from its training and act according to natural instincts which may include but are not limited to stopping, changing directions or speed at will, shifting its weight, bucking, biting & running from danger.

_____ 8) **Rider Responsibility:** I UNDERSTAND THAT: Upon mounting a horse and taking up the reins the rider is in primary control of the horse. The rider’s safety largely depends upon his/her ability to carry out simple instructions, and his/her ability to remain balanced aboard the moving animal. I agree that the rider shall be responsible for his/her safety and that of an unborn child if the rider is pregnant. THIS STABLE advises pregnant woman not to ride horses, unless permission is given under advice of her physician.

_____ 9) **Liability Release:** In consideration of THIS STABLE allowing my participation in this activity, under the terms set forth herein I, the rider, and the parent or legal guardian thereof if a minor, do agree to hold harmless and release THIS STABLE its owners, agents, employees, officers, members, premises owners, insurers and affiliated organizations from legal liability due to THIS STABLES ordinary negligence and I do further agree that except in the event of THIS STABLE’S gross and willful negligence, I shall bring no claims, demands, actions and causes of action, and/or litigation against THIS STABLES and IT’S ASSOCIATES as stated above in this clause, for any economic and noneconomic losses due to bodily injury, death, property damage, sustained by me and/or my minor child or legal ward in relation to the premises and operations of THIS STABLE to include riding, handling or otherwise being near animals or horses owned by or in the care, custody and control of THIS STABLE. **ZIP CODE** _____
